Re: Approval of SOC and Military Transfer Credits

The School of Construction is seeking approval of the Serviceman Opportunity College (SOC) and military experience credits (listed in Table 1: Transfer Credits) for potential transfer into the Construction Engineering Technology bachelor of science program to facilitate rapid evaluation of military transcripts.

Table 1: Category A represents military experience and training that Southern Miss has traditionally accepted and shows the corresponding SOC number that is displayed on a student's transcript.

Table 1: Category B is a listing of currently guaranteed SOC transfer courses. Since it is likely that Southern Miss will be moved from a guaranteed status to an affiliate status, we wish to maintain (internally) the guarantee of these courses's transferability.

Table 1: Category C lists courses that are not currently guaranteed; however, we seek approval for transfer of these credits for the Construction Engineering Technology major only from the three predominant potential transfer institutions (Coastline Community College, University of Maryland, and/or Thomas Edison State College). Table 2 provides listings of equivalent courses from these three institutions corresponding to Table 1: Category C; evaluations of other institutions will be conducted on a case-by-case basis.
